Born in Bologna (Italy) back in 1964, Andrea Cimatti is interested in both artistic and technical aspects of photography. He prefers fine art photography of landscapes, focusing especially on the rare and short-lived moments when the light merges with the other natural elements creating unrepeatable images which turn conventional landscapes into ethereal sceneries. These views lead to a deep introspection and romantic astonishment in front of the mysterious wonder of the nature and its relationships with human states of mind.

His artwork attempts to catch these magical moments and transfer them into perceptible representations where the human being is only a spectator or, when present, never plays a main character role, but simply an evanescent and respectful presence. The main goal of this photographic artwork is to express states of mind through the global merging of natural colours, light and shades in order to generate profound spiritual feelings. Through the inspiration of universal and ancestral emotional impressions, everybody can find her/his own interpretation behind these images.

He has been always impressed and inspired by the following sentence of Mark Rothko:

"If you are only moved by color relationships, you are missing the point. I am interested in expressing the big emotions - tragedy, ecstasy, doom."

Andrea uses both analogical and digital cameras, avoiding as much as possible the excessive image post-processing and manipulation of digital images in order to preserve the original role of photography and exploit the ability of the photographer in reproducing the observed subjects, without transforming photographic art into a software-driven graphical virtuosity.

He is also interested in urban landscapes, as well as in abstract subjects, and displayed his artwork in several exhibitions in Italy.
