- 2016 13 **Studio 4D: Time-based Work** (Final Cut Pro X, Dragonframe, Adobe AfterEffects CC) This is a required core studio course that focuses on both the concepts of time-based art and design and the tools and methods necessary to create this work. Assignments in video, animation, sound, and real time/live art serve to provide students with a range of approaches to creating works that utilize time and movement and are experiential in nature.
- 2016 10 **Detroit Connections: In the Classroom** detroitconnections.org

 Connecting A&D students with 4th graders at Bennett School in Detroit through visual arts projects, this class is a combination of work with children at the Bennett campus, contextual projects, site visits and literature that address the issues of urban schools, Detroit's history and neighborhoods, and the radical transformation creative work can have on cognitive development and civic engagement.
- Art for Social Change: Japan japanartforchange.tumblr.com Students spend three weeks in Kyoto and in Shigaraki, the ancient ceramic center of Japan now acclaimed for progressive work with people with cognitive disabilities. Students work collaboratively with local artists, school children and curatorial staff from area museums to experience the impact of art on community. The course also explores contemporary art practices including two days exploring Naoshima Island's Art House Project and permanent installations by James Turrell, Mariko Mori, Walter De Maria and others.
- Art at Mott Hospital: Creativity in a Medical Setting students work with art therapists and directly with inpatient pediatric patients. Students are responsible for ideation and development of creative projects with patients of various levels of wellness and capability. Through readings, students learn of the role of creativity in a medical setting and patterns of discrimination toward people with disabilities. Students work creatively to explore empathy and to unravel their own judgments and biases.
