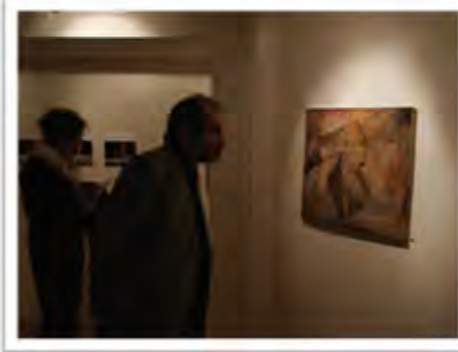


# Bio Events

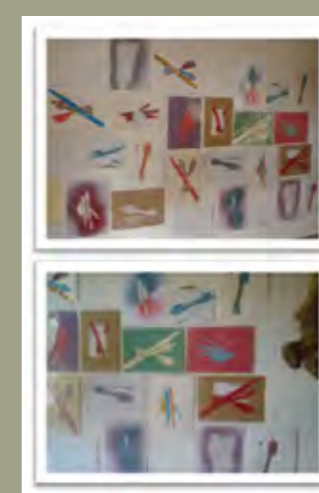
